2024 Festival Particulars

- The Brant Music Festival uses the syllabus that you see available here.
- Registration opened Monday, January 1, 2024 at 6:00 PM and is available at brantmusicfestival.music
- Registration closes Tuesday, March 26, 2024 at 11:59 PM
- Payments are processed through MusicFestivalSuite using Stripe, and are subject to a transaction fee equalling 3.50% of the total invoice
- To register, all Parents/Guardians and Teachers/Group Leaders must make a Profile with the Brant Music Festival's MusicFestivalSuite Portal before a Participant makes their own Profile. A Parent/Guardian can create a Profile for their minor children easily from within their own Profile. A Teacher/Group Leader can create a Profile for their ensemble(s) easily from within their own Profile. If you already have a MusicFestivalSuite Profile with another festival, you can Export your Profile from that festival to the Brant Music Festival easily from within your Profile with that festival.
- The Brant Music Festival has currently scheduled the live festival to take place from 9:00 AM, April 29, 2024 to 9:30 PM, May 4, 2024.

Brant Music Festival Overall Rules

BRANT MUSIC FESTIVAL RULES

GENERAL

- 1. The Brant Music Festival reserves the right to refuse any entry or cancel any class, with the exception of this rule, entry fees will **NOT** be refunded.
- 2. The Brant Music Festival reserves the right to divide or combine classes.
- 3. Where age limits are specified, participants must be of the prescribed age on December 31st of the previous year.
- 4. All classes are open to amateurs defined as any person whose principal means of livelihood is not derived from the profession of music.
- 5. Please note that the Brant Music Festival will run from 9:00 AM to 9:30 PM Monday to Saturday. Participants are expected to perform at their scheduled time. No changes once the programme has been set.
- 6. Please read the NOTES at the top of each section. Any special rules applicable to a particular section or class will be deemed part of the official rules.

GENERAL PERFORMANCE

- The most recent RCM, Royal Conservatory of Music, and CC Conservatory Canada syllabus MUST be used. Crossover times in the event of a new syllabus will be observed as in the Conservatory.
- 2. All pieces must be performed from memory, unless otherwise stated. The use of music will result in adjudication ONLY, with no mark given. Exceptions are noted in individual classes.
- 3. Unless otherwise specified, all instrumental pieces must be played without repeats.
- 4. Da Capos and Dal Segnos must be observed.
- 5. Time limits, where specified, will be strictly enforced.
- 6. Duet classes do not need to be memorized. However, if music is used, there must be an original copy of the music for both performers AND the adjudicator. The use of photocopies will result in adjudication ONLY, with no mark given.
- 7. During quick study and sight reading classes the room will be closed to the public. They return in for the adjudication.
- 8. For accompanists, photocopies of copyrighted music will be allowed, **provided there is a second original copy in the room.**
- 9. Participants must provide their own live accompaniment. No taped accompaniment.
- 10. All participants must supply an **original** copy of their piece, with bar measures numbered, for the adjudicator.

ENTRIES

- 1. All entries must be received by March 26, 2024 and accompanied by the correct fee stated for each class. **Late entries will not be accepted.**
- 2. Registration payments may be made through the Music Festival Suites online registration system.
- 3. If other payment options are utilized, an NSF fee of \$35.00 will be charged where

- applicable. Any subsequent payment must be paid in CASH or MONEY ORDER.
- 4. Participants are limited to one entry per class.
- 5. For duets or ensemble classes one entry form is required. Please make sure all participant names and birthdays are clearly marked.
- 6. Participant's performing schedules will be forwarded to both the teacher and the participant.
- 7. Adjudicators may not evaluate their own students.
- 8. The adjudicator will discuss the performance of each participant by only the marks of 3rd, 2nd, and 1st will be read out loud. Everyone will receive a written report.
- 9. To be considered for an award, you must compete in 2 or more solo classes (not including quick study or sight reading.)
- 10. Videotaping and photography are allowed by **family** of their own child. **Videotaping the adjudication is strictly forbidden and will result in immediate disqualification.**
- 11. Signing of the registration gives permission for use of photos on the website or newspaper.

DECORUM

- Any questions or concerns should be directed to the festival board or hall manager, and not directly with the adjudicator. Any contact with the adjudicator is strictly forbidden and will result in disqualification.
- All performers and spectators are expected to act in a professional and courteous manner towards their fellow competitors and with the adjudicators. Failure to adhere to this code of conduct may result in disciplinary action at the discretion of the Discipline Committees and the Festival Board.
- 3. The Brant Music Festival is committed to providing a safe and inclusive space for all students to perform and learn. If you anticipate any barriers to your child's learning and participation in the festival, please contact the Discipline Head directly to explore potential options for accessibility.
- 4. ADJUDICATORS DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

Brass and Woodwind

- 1. Memorization is encouraged, but not required.
- 2. Pieces with piano accompaniment must be accompanied by a live pianist. Participants are responsible for arranging their accompanist
- 3. Selections may be used in one class only.

Choir and Band

- 1. Please ensure that you have read and understand the rules and regulations of the 2024 Syllabus.
- All school ensembles must be supervised by an adequate number of staff members or volunteers in order to ensure proper discipline. Please follow the supervision guidelines laid out by your board/organization for the student to adult ratio.
- 3. Choral selections must be limited to any 3 verses.
- 4. Choirs may warm up for 1 minute only when assembled for performance.
- 5. Piano accompaniment only.
- 6. All choirs should arrive 20 minutes prior to their performance time.
- 7. Bands should arrive 30 minutes prior to performance time.
- 8. A communal waiting room will be assigned to each group where students will get their instruments ready and leave their instrument cases and outdoor clothing.
- 9. After a warm-up session, groups will proceed to the performance room. Members will sit together in an assigned area. Performers will stay in the room, with their group until their class has been adjudicated and dismissed.

 perform in at least THREE classes in section VCL01.
- The Keighley's Jewellers Junior Rose Bowl is open to competitors performing at Grade 8 or 9 level. Pieces must be from the current Conservatory Syllabus. To be eligible for this bowl, competitors MUST perform in at least THREE classes in section VCL02.
- 4. Winners of the Donna Chapin Crystal Rose Bowl and Keighley's Jewellers Junior Rose Bowl are eligible for the Overall Festival Award The Richard and Virginia Blaha Memorial Silver Tray. Trophy finals will take place at the Saturday Evening Competition May 4, 2024
- 5. Original copies of musical scores must be given to the adjudicator. The use of photocopies will result in adjudication only.
- 6. Non-Competitive classes are NOT eligible for trophies and awards. Marks will NOT be given. Music need not be memorized.

Brant Music Festival - English Speech Arts Discipline Rules

1. Age-based level Classes are offered to competitors in each of the following eight levels:

<u>Beginner Level</u>: Competitors between the ages of 6-8 as of December 31, 2023

Primary Level: Competitors between the ages of 9-10 as of December 31, 2023

Elementary Level: Competitors between the ages of 11-12 as of December 31, 2023

Junior Level: Competitors between the ages of 13-14 as of December 31, 2023

Intermediate Level: Competitors between the ages of 15-16 as of December 31, 2023.

Senior Level: Competitors between the ages of 17-18 as of December 31, 2023.

Advanced Level: Competitors between the ages of 19-25 as of December 31, 2023.

2. Speech Arts GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Memorization is required, except for Public Speaking where cue cards are allowed.
- Participants must provide the adjudicator with an original copy of the work being performed. Failure to do so will result in a "for adjudication only" performance.
- All selections must be taken from published works unless otherwise specified. The RCM Speech Arts Syllabus is a good resource for examples of poetry & prose excerpts for all ages.
- Competitors will be evaluated on age appropriate selections, poise, elocution, and stage presence.
- Storytelling Own Composition. Participants must provide a printed copy of their piece.
- Props & Costumes are allowed, but will not be judged. One stage and one hand prop is permitted.
- PROVINCIALS: Beginner to Advanced levels are eligible for Provincial nomination. Students
 must enter two (2) classes in this discipline to qualify, but only ONE qualifying selection will be
 entered as the adjudicator's recommendation on the OMFA form and must be performed at
 Provincials. Provincial rules are available by visiting www.omfa.ca, the Ontario Music Festival
 Association's website.

3. Speech Arts Definitions:

a) Poetry Solo Categories

<u>Lyric Poetry</u>: – a short poem that is contemplative, an expression of the inner thoughts and feelings of the poet. It includes sonnets, odes and elegies. Selections exhibit a graceful musical rhythm and flow. The content is reflective and emotional, typically written in the first person, and the story element is of secondary importance to the emotion/feeling. Not dramatized. No (or limited) movement or

gestures so that attention is never drawn away from the language. (Examples include select works of Dickinson, Shelley, Keats, Rossetti, Tagore, etc.)

<u>Narrative Poetry</u>: – a poem that tells a story, or recounts an event, through verse. It contains a plot, characters, and a setting. It often contains action and dialogue but is told from the narrator's perspective. Usually written in metered verse but does not need to rhyme. Gestures are allowed for emphasis but it is not dramatized. Any movement should flow naturally from the text and the narrator's interpretation. (Examples include select works of Poe, Longfellow, Tennyson, St. Vincent Millay, etc.)

<u>Canadian Poetry</u>: – a published poem written by a Canadian/Indigenous poet. (Examples include select works of Roberts, Service, Carson, Lampman, Atwood, Cohen, Montgomery, Ondaatje, Thomas, etc.)

<u>Original Poetry</u>: – Competitors perform their own original poem from memory. Performance will be assessed on content, delivery, creativity and originality.

b) Prose Solo

An excerpt (in paragraph form) from a published story, novel, or essay (fiction or non-fiction). The passage may be abridged to form a unified whole. Prose is non-metrical writing and thus, stories written in verse are not permitted. Selection should include narration, description and dialogue. It should be spoken in a story-telling style and not performed as a dramatic scene. No acting and limited movement around the stage. Competitor may stand or be seated.

c) Shakespeare Monologue

Choice of a scene or play by William Shakespeare. Scene may be abridged so that the monologue includes only the words of one character Simple portable props and simple costuming are allowed.

d) Monologue Other Than Shakespeare

Choice of a scene depicting one character from a published play or published anthology of monologues. Scene may be abridged so that the monologue includes only the words of one character. Simple portable props and simple costuming are allowed.

e) Storytelling Solo

Competitors may write their own original story, or retell, in their own words, a published folk, fairy tale, myth or legend.

f) Public Speaking Solo

Competitors will prepare and present an original organized speech on a topic of their choice. Content must be suitable for all ages/audiences. The speech should have a defined purpose and clear structure. The speech may be delivered to entertain, influence, or inform the audience. Cue cards are permitted, but eye contact should engage the audience.
